English Tasks

<p>Task 1 – Science Label the parts of the heart on the diagram.</p>	<p>Task 2 – Geography Look at the flags from countries taking part in the Olympics. Name the country the flag represents and find out the capital city of that country.</p>	<p>Task 3 – PSHE Reach out to somebody, show an interest and give up your time to listen. Find out about their life. You could choose to make a display or draw a picture to celebrate their life.</p>
<p>Task 4 – History Watch the video on the Ancient Olympics and answer the questions on it.</p>	<p>Task 5 – Online Safety Listen to the story 'When Charlie McButton lost power'. Create a poster about healthy choices online- how much time should you spend online? What could you do instead?</p>
